

The following article was published in March 2015, in the Southern Arizona newspaper *Connection* based in Arivaca, Arizona. I wrote this in response to an article that was published in the previous edition of *Connection* from a group called People Helping People in the Border Zone. This is an organization that advocates on behalf of illegal immigrants.

## **Foresight**

Foresight: noun, fore sight. The ability to see what will or might happen in the future. 1. An act or the power of foreseeing 2. Provident care. John had the foresight to invest wisely.

The 1965 Buffy Sainte-Marie album *Many a Mile* includes the song, *Welcome, Welcome Emigrante* in which Buffy welcomes immigrants to America which was easy for her since she was an immigrant from Canada herself. That was fifty years ago when the population of America was 194 million compared with today's 320 million which makes America the third most populous country in the world. America's population has almost doubled in the past fifty years and it continues to increase by about a million people a year. This can't be good. Adding more people to an already over-populated country will not increase the quality of life for the people living here.

Advocates for continued population growth often have their hearts in the right place, they want people from third-world countries to be able to come to America and realize their dreams. They want people from less fortunate countries to be able to enjoy the freedoms and opportunities that America offers. They are good-hearted people concerned about the welfare of their fellow man. However, they lack foresight. America cannot continue to take in the world's starving masses. We are already experiencing a lower standard of living and a declining quality of life. Because they lack foresight, they cannot see a few decades into the

future when America will descend to the level of China or India, the only two countries with more people than America.

As well-meaning as they are, the pro-immigration, open-borders advocates are on the wrong side of the numbers. For example, they claim that in the past ten years Border Patrol agents have killed 48 people. Google “Illegal alien statistics” or anything similar, and you will quickly realize the folly of allowing continued immigration.

Some pro-immigration zealots say that border deaths are the result of border enforcement. That’s just silly. Border deaths are the result of immigrants trying to cross illegally into this country. They are the result of ignorant people thinking they can walk across that desert. The immigrant defenders will claim that an illegal alien who dies 20 miles north of Phoenix a year after entering the country illegally was a “border death”.

Anyone who aids and abets an illegal immigrant by putting out water or offering a ride should be charged with aiding and abetting an illegal immigrant in the commission of a felony, and they should be arrested. These poor misguided souls in an effort to feel good about themselves are contributing to the deaths of innocent native born Americans. They
